



**DECLARATION OF A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY
(ORDER BY CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT)**

WHEREAS people, property and the environment (or the local economy) are at risk from landslide in Electoral Areas A and B.

AND WHEREAS the threat posed by landslide continues to require early warning for and preparation by those potentially or actually affected, or protection of infrastructure, property, possessions or the environment, as well as prompt coordination of response and recovery actions, or special regulations of access, activities, persons property or the environment, to protect the health, safety or welfare of people, or to limit damage to property or the following environment within the designated areas of the Cariboo Regional District circumscribed in the paragraphs following;










NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to Section 12(1) of the *Emergency Program Act* (RS, 1996, Chap 111) and Section 5.2 of the *Cariboo Regional District Emergency Program, Regulatory Bylaw No. 4060, 2005*, that a STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY NOW EXISTS in:

- Electoral Areas A and B, within the boundaries of the Cariboo Regional District,

due to landslide, which could potentially result in the loss or destruction of infrastructure, property, possessions or the environment as well as having a severe impact on the local economy and the well-being of the community;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the Cariboo Regional District, its employees, servants and agents are empowered pursuant to Section 13(1) of the *Emergency Program Act* to do all acts and implement all procedures that are considered necessary to prevent or to alleviate the effects of the emergency, including:

	Authorize the entry into any building or on any land, without warrant, by any person in the course of implementing an emergency plan or program or if otherwise considered by the minister to be necessary to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster;	CRD	RCMP
	Cause the demolition or removal of any trees, structures or crops if the demolition or removal is considered by the minister to be necessary or appropriate in order to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster;	CRD	
	Construct works considered by the minister to be necessary or appropriate to prevent, respond to or alleviate the effects of an emergency or disaster; and	CRD	
	Procure, fix prices for or ration food, clothing, fuel, equipment, medical supplies or other essential supplies and the use of any property, services, resources or equipment within any part of British Columbia for the duration of the state of emergency.	CRD	

AND BE IT ALSO KNOWN THAT the Cariboo Regional District hereby advises the Minister Responsible of the Province of British Columbia, and the population within the aforementioned area, that a STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY exists;

AND BE IT ALSO KNOWN THAT this ORDER and STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY will remain in force for seven days from 2/10/2021 to 2/16/2021 at midnight, unless cancelled by order of the Cariboo Regional District or the Minister responsible;

ORDERED by the Chair of the Board of the Cariboo Regional District at 2:30 p.m. this 2/3/2021.
