



# CRD Evacuation Alert

## Titetown and Nazko North Area

Sunday, July 11, 2021 at 6:15 pm

An Evacuation Alert expansion has been issued by Cariboo Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC). This alert is replacing the Hanham - Titetown Area Alert issued at 3:00 pm on Tuesday, July 6, 2021.

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the Cariboo Regional District has issued an Evacuation Alert for the following areas:

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be required.

Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

### **WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT**

Upon notification of an **ALERT**, you should be prepared for an evacuation order by:

- Having a plan to transport all family members or co-workers outside of the area, should the area be brought under evacuation order.
- Keeping essential items readily available for a quick departure; including medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), immediate care needs for dependents and, if you choose, keepsakes (photographs, etc).
- Ensuring that any dependents are prepared for departure.
- Prepare to move people with disabilities, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Moving pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Ensuring that you have accommodation options for your family, if possible. A Reception Centre will be made available if required.
- In the event you are evacuated, **do not** shut off your natural gas. For more information, visit [fortisbc.com/forestfires](https://fortisbc.com/forestfires).
