



CRD Evacuation Alert And Partial Lift Tweedsmuir Park Area

Thursday, September 13, 2018 at 10:00 am

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Cariboo Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC) to reflect a **partial Order Lift and downgrade**. This alert is rescinding and replacing the Tweedsmuir Park Area Order issued at 12:30 pm on August 29, 2018 as **per the attached map**.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be required.


Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Upon notification of an **ALERT**, you should be prepared for an evacuation order by:

- Having a plan to transport all family members or co-workers outside of the area, should the area be brought under evacuation order.
- Keeping essential items readily available for a quick departure; including medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), immediate care needs for dependents and, if you choose, keepsakes (photographs, etc).
- Ensuring that any dependents are prepared for departure.
- Moving pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Ensuring that you have accommodation options for your family, if possible. A Reception Centre will be made available if required.
- Monitoring reliable news sources for information on evacuation orders and locations of Reception Centres and the CRD's channels on Facebook and cariboord.ca/emergency.
