



CRD Evacuation Alert Forglen Road

Friday, May 1, 2020 at 4:00 pm

Pursuant to the BC Emergency Program Act, the evacuation order for **Forglen Road** is being **rescinded and replaced** by the following Alert Area by the Cariboo Regional District at the Emergency Operations Centre (EOC):

- **6166 Forglen Road – See attached map**

In an alert area, you must remain prepared to evacuate your premises or property should it be required. Due to ongoing activities, access to some areas may be limited.


Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT

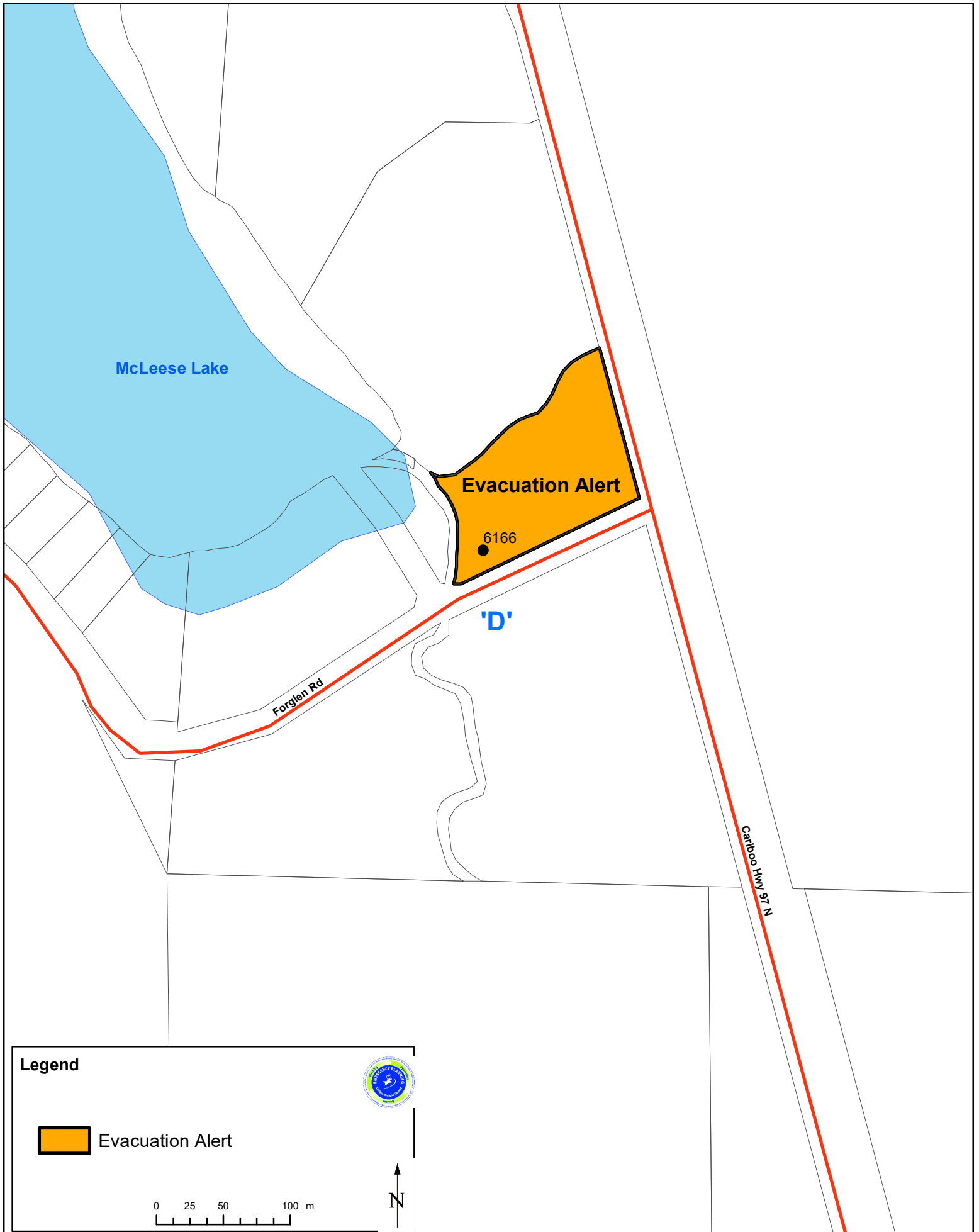
Upon notification of an **ALERT**, you should be prepared for the evacuation order:

- Have a plan to transport all family members or co-workers outside of the area, should the area be brought back under evacuation order.
- Keep essential items readily available for a quick departure; including medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), immediate care needs for dependents and, if you choose, keepsakes (photographs, etc).
- Ensure that any dependents or pets are prepared for departure.
- Move pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Ensure that you have accommodation options for your family, if possible. A Reception Centre will be made available if required.
- In the event you are evacuated, do not shut off your natural gas.
- If you are on an evacuation ALERT, or if you have been displaced from your home due to an emergency, please self-register for Emergency Support Services. Self-Registration will reduce wait times for evacuees and assist in the referral process. <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/>
