Plastic Bags and Overwrap

Material Description Do not include Plastic bags & Plastic bags for: Crinkly cellophane wrap, for groceries, dry tea, floral arrangements, etc. overwrap cleaning, bread, Stand up pouches produce, dry bulk Bags for pre-washed salad foods, and most Kitchen stretch wrap or plastic frozen vegetables wrap for meat, poultry, fish or Outer bags and wrap for: cheese diapers, feminine BREAD Chip or snack bags hygiene products, Zipper-lock sandwich and paper towels, tissues, freezer bags soft drink can flats: Plastic shipping envelopes bags for water Packaging labelled softener salt, wood biodegradable or compostable pellets and garden Soft packaging for perishable products foods, e.g. bacon, deli meats, Overwrap on: cheese slices, fish, etc. mattresses, furniture Lumber or construction wrap and electronic Garbage bags or recycling – equipment e.g. "blue bags" or any bag sold as a product (all colours) All bags should be free of food residue and products.







Foam Packaging (Styrofoam)
