Curbside Instructions

1. Have your tote at the curb by 8:00 a.m.
2. Place your tote so that the lid opens towards the street.
3. Place tote on level ground away from vehicles and other obstacles.
4. Ensure tote lid is closed.
5. Place all items inside the tote.



Collection Schedule

The first collection day is scheduled for **Tuesday October 7th, 2025**. Garbage will be collected every week on Tuesday or Wednesday.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can I still use my existing garbage can?

A. No, curbside garbage collection will be done with an automated garbage truck, which requires a specialized tote for collection.

Q. Do I have to pay for my garbage tote, and is it mine to take if I move?

A. No, the CRD secured grant funding to purchase garbage totes, they are the property of the CRD and must remain with the property if you move. Each tote has a serial number for tracking.

Q. Can I have more than one garbage tote?

A. Yes, if your property is zoned for a secondary suite, a carriage house, or secondary dwelling (duplex) and one of the above is present*, additional totes will be supplied upon request by the property owner. Annual bills will reflect the number of totes provided; i.e. if there are two totes you will be billed for two services. Addition tote request forms can be found on the website or contact us.

Q. How much will the service cost?

A. Each property owner will be billed \$99.96 annually in April for each household tote. If paid before the end of May, a 10% discount will apply, reducing the total to \$89.96, working out to about \$7.50/month per tote.

Q. Do I have to participate in this service?

A. Yes, this is not an optional service. The CRD is working with Recycle BC so that both garbage and recycling services can be provided. One of Recycle BC's stipulations is that all homes within designated collection areas are included in the service. Q. What goes in the recycling collection bins?

A. Recycle BC is responsible for recycling collection, promotion and education. Recycle BC will provide information with your new recycling containers, and you can visit recyclebc.ca for more information.



Be Bear Aware

Place totes at the curb the morning of your collection day, not the night before.

Not Everything Is Garbage

Recyclables and hazardous materials such as batteries (all kinds), electronics, chemicals, medications, paint, propane canisters/tanks, automotive oil, and fuels are not permitted in garbage totes.
