



Russet Bluff Water System Advisory

Effective June 11th, 2026

The Cariboo Regional District has downgraded the Boil Water Notice for the Russet Bluff Water System to a water quality advisory.

This Advisory remains in effect until further notice.

Interior Health has authorized the Cariboo Regional District (CRD) to downgrade the Boil Water Notice for the Russet Bluff Water System to a Water Quality Advisory.

The advisory is in place due to the use of untreated water from the lower well, which has been designated as a Groundwater Source at Risk of Pathogens (GARP). The advisory will remain in effect until further notice.

Residents are no longer required to boil water before consumption or use an alternate water supply. However, seniors, young children, and individuals with compromised immune systems or other health concerns may wish to continue taking these precautions.

The CRD will continue to monitor water quality and work closely with Interior Health while the advisory remains in place. Regular water sampling and system monitoring will continue as required.

A separate Water Quality Advisory related to manganese concentrations in the lower well water source also remains in effect. Residents with questions regarding either advisory are encouraged to contact the CRD Utilities Department.

Both advisories will remain in effect until further notice. Updates will be provided as new information becomes available.
