



CRD Evacuation Order South Canim Lake Area

EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED

Friday, September 1, 2017 at 3:45 pm

Pursuant to the BC Emergency Program Act, an Evacuation Order has been issued by the Cariboo Regional District. This order is a result of a previous tactical evacuation.

Due to immediate danger to life safety due to fire, members of the RCMP or other groups will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following area:

The evacuation route is:

Canim Lake Road to 100 Mile House.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area **immediately**
- Register at the ESS Centre in 100 Mile House at the South Cariboo Recreation Centre at 175 Wrangler Way. If you require group lodging, please continue on to Williams Lake to the Gibraltar Room in the Cariboo Memorial Complex at 525 Proctor Street.
- Close all windows and doors
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock
- Gather your family: take a neighbour or someone who needs help
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and Keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
