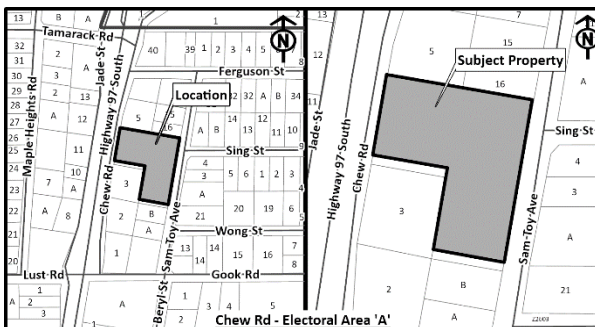

The Board of Directors of the Cariboo Regional District gives notice that it will hold a Public Hearing to consider proposed Bylaw 5573.

Quesnel Fringe Area Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 5573, 2026 amends Bylaw No. 3504, 1999 by rezoning the property from Service Commercial (C 4) zone to Special Exception C 4-4 zone.

If passed, it will allow service commercial uses and a contractor's office, shop and yard.

All persons who believe that their interest in property may be affected by the proposed Bylaw(s) shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard at the public hearing.
