Palmer Creek Fire Area **EVACUATION ORDER**

Saturday, August 8, 2026 at 8:00PM

Whereas a declaration of a State of Local Emergency was declared on August 8, 2026 pursuant to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to wildfire within Electoral Area 'J'

AND pursuant to Section 107 (1)(c) and (d) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by Ts'ideldel First Nation, Ts'ilhqot'in National Government and the Cariboo Regional District due to the immediate danger to life safety caused by the wildfire and is effective as of August 8, 2026 at 8:00PM. This Evacuation Order replaces the Evacuation Alert issued August 7, 2026 for the Palmer Creek Fire Area.

The evacuation order is now in effect for the following areas:

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY. Members of the RCMP and other applicable agencies may be expediting this action.

A person must not enter the area identified in the attached map for purposes of residing, occupying or visiting the area.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area immediately.
- If it is safe to do so, check on friends and neighbours to see if they need assistance.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO (continued):

- Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Take critical items (medicine, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available.
- Close all windows and doors; close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Do not shut off your natural gas. FortisBC will turn off natural gas service as needed.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
- Do not use more vehicles than you must.
- To receive Emergency Support Services, please self-register using the Evacuee Registration & Assistance (ERA) tool at <https://ess.gov.bc.ca>
- If you have homeowners' or tenants' insurance, contact your insurance provider.
- Residents who choose not to evacuate should understand they stay at their own risk. Responders may not be able to come to your rescue if it is unsafe to do so.

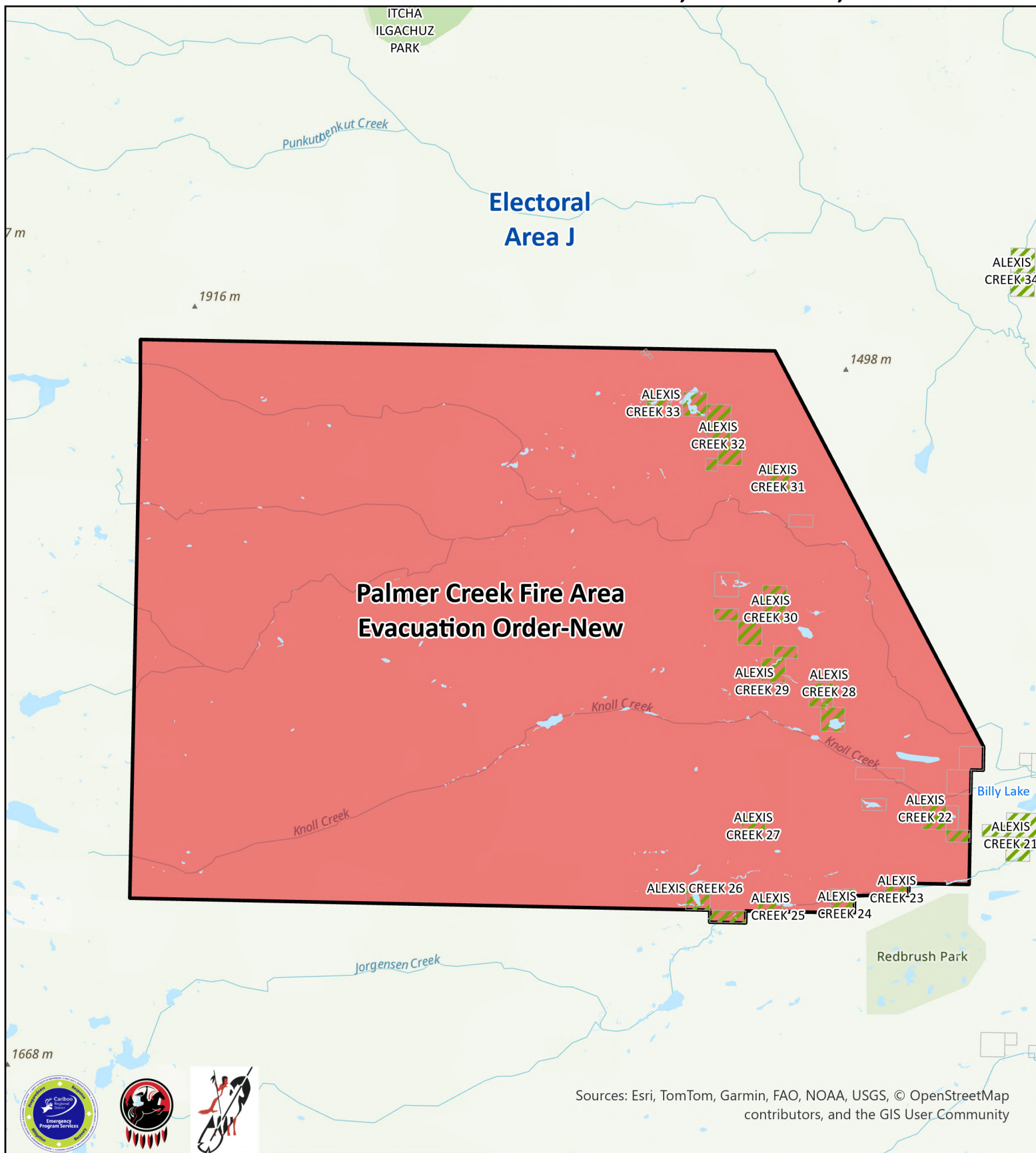
