Fiftynine Creek (Pear Lake) Fire Area 5

EVACUATION ALERT

Monday, August 10, 2026, at 8:00 a.m.

Pursuant to the Emergency and Disaster Management Act, the evacuation order issued on Friday, July 31, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. for the Fiftynine Creek (Pear Lake) Fire Area is being rescinded and replaced with the following alert by the Cariboo Regional District Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

In an alert area, you must remain prepared to evacuate your premises or property should it be required. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however, you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

- Fill your vehicle with gas before returning and keep tank full in case you need to leave again.
- Bring a minimum of three days of food and essential supplies (e.g. medications, pet supplies) with you as local grocery stores may not yet have adequate stock.
- Have a plan to transport all family members should the area be brought back under evacuation order
- Keep essential items readily available for a quick departure, including medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), immediate care needs for dependents and, if you choose, keepsakes (photographs, etc).
- Ensure that any dependents or pets are prepared for departure.
- Ensure that you have accommodation options for your family, if possible. A Reception Centre will be made available again if required.
- Monitor reliable news sources and the CRD's channels on Facebook and cariboord.ca.

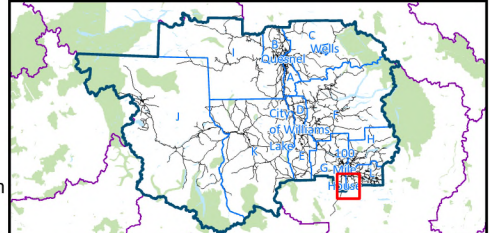
