

ADDENDUM No. 02

Cariboo Regional District: Request for Proposals: # 26-007:

Addendum number 02 is issued to the Cariboo Regional District Request for Proposal # 26-007 to accommodate the inclusion of the Maps for the CWRP Locations.

CHANGE 1:

1. In 2023, we developed a CWRP for the Xení Gwet'in First Nation in the Nemiah Valley. How would the Cariboo Regional District like to include or reference other existing CWRPs in the development of this project? Would those plans be updated in this process, or simply references? **The other CWRPs would be from First Nations. We would want you to read them and make them compatible but we would not want our plans referencing the other CWRPs. The CRD will not be responsible for updating other CWRPs, they are not our plans to update.**
2. Following question 1, what other CWRPs and WUI WRR plans have been developed in the six eligible regional districts? **First Nations CWRPs but no WRR plans**
3. Looking at the maps in the RFP, we noticed there are lots of small EWUI polygons. Do you expect that we complete a sight visit on every one of these polygons? **Yes**
4. Looking at the map, it appears that Indian Reserve Lands have been netted out of the EWUI. How does the Regional District want to address IR Land in the CWRPs? How will these First Nation communities be included in the CWRP development and engagement process? **IR land is not in the CRD CWRPs. The consultants would engage with local First Nations to gather information so our CWRPs were cohesive with each other.**
1. On Pg 24, the deadline is Oct.29, 2025. Is it correct to assume it's Oct. 29, 2026? **Yes sorry 2026.**
2. The RFP references the 2023 CWRP template and instruction guide. Do you prefer that we use the older version of the template and guidance manual? **We recommend the latest version of the template please.**
3. Are there any new addenda or Q&A for this RFP? **Not that I am aware of.**
4. Will there be an opportunity to Extend the Deadline. **If it the reference is for the October 29, 2026 deadline then NO. The Firesmart Team requires time after receiving the completed reports to provide the required information to the Provincial Government.**
