

- Flatten cardboard, remove plastic wrap from cardboard flats. Staples and tape okay.
- Return deposit containers for a refund.

Exclude batteries: medical sharps; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; containers with the words COMBUSTIBLE. FLAMMABLE or VERY FLAMMABLE on them (except cosmetic and beauty product containers); compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants. or antifreeze: or containers for pesticides with the words . DANGER. WARNING. or POISON, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with

skull and cross bones.


