EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED

Friday, August 4, 2017 at 10:45 am

Pursuant to the BC Emergency Program Act, an expanded Evacuation Order has been issued by the Cariboo Regional District. This order is replacing the South of Highway 20 to Alex Lake order issued on July 28, 2017 at 2:00 pm.

Due to immediate danger to **life safety** due to fire, members of the RCMP or other groups will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following area:

The evacuation route is:

Churn Creek Bridge at Gang Ranch, follow Dog Creek Road to Williams Lake.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area immediately
- Register at the ESS table in the Resiliency Centre in Williams Lake at Boitanio Mall. Those requiring group lodging will be required to continue on to the ESS Reception Centre in Prince George at the College of New Caledonia
- Close all windows and doors
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock
- Gather your family: take a neighbour or someone who needs help
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and Keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
