

Cariboo Regional District Flexible Plastics Recycling Contest Official Terms and Conditions

1. Acceptance

By submitting an online contest entry, participants acknowledge that they have read and agree to these Terms and Conditions.

2. Contest Period

The contest begins July 1, 2026 and closes September 1, 2026. Entries submitted after the contest closes will not be accepted.

3. Eligibility

The contest is open to anyone who recycles accepted flexible plastics at a participating Cariboo Regional District transfer station during the contest period and submits a valid online entry. No purchase is necessary to enter or win.

4. How to Enter

Recycle accepted flexible plastics at a participating transfer station and receive an entry card with a unique entry code. Complete the online entry form using the unique code. One online entry is permitted per qualifying drop-off, per day. Each unique code may only be used once.

5. Prizes

There are three (3) prizes available. Each prize consists of one (1) \$100 gift certificate to a local business chosen by the winner. Gift certificates are not redeemable for cash, are non-transferable, and must be accepted as awarded.

6. Winner Selection

Three winners will be selected by random draw after the contest closes. Winners will be contacted by email using the address provided on the online entry form. If a selected winner cannot be contacted or does not respond within fourteen (14) days, the Cariboo Regional District may conduct an additional draw for that prize.

7. Privacy

Personal information is collected solely for the purpose of administering the contest, contacting winners, and in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (British Columbia).

8. Disqualification

The Cariboo Regional District reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is incomplete, fraudulent, duplicated, uses an invalid or altered entry code, or otherwise does not comply with these Terms and Conditions.

9. Limitation of Liability

The Cariboo Regional District is not responsible for lost, late, incomplete, misdirected, or technically unavailable entries, or for technical failures affecting participation.

10. Changes or Cancellation

The Cariboo Regional District reserves the right to amend, suspend, or cancel the contest if necessary to protect the integrity or administration of the contest or due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

11. Decisions

All decisions of the Cariboo Regional District regarding the contest are final.
