EVACUATION ORDER

Wednesday, July 22, 2026, at 8:45 p.m.

Whereas a declaration of a State of Local Emergency was declared on July 22, 2026 pursuant to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to wildfire within Electoral Area 'I'

AND pursuant to Section 107 (1)(c) and (d) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Cariboo Regional District due to the immediate danger to life safety caused by the wildfire and is effective as of July 22, 2026 at 8:45 p.m.

The evacuation order is now in effect for the following areas: **See attached map**

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY. Members of the RCMP and other applicable agencies may be expediting this action.

If you require Emergency Support Services, please travel to Quesnel and call 250-983-3638 for assistance. Please note that Emergency Support Services are available only to people whose primary residence is currently under an evacuation order.

A person must not enter the area identified in the attached map for purposes of residing, occupying or visiting the area.

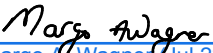
WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area **immediately**.
- Gather your family; take a neighbour or someone who needs help.
- Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available.
- Close all windows and doors; close gates (latch) but do not lock.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO (continued):

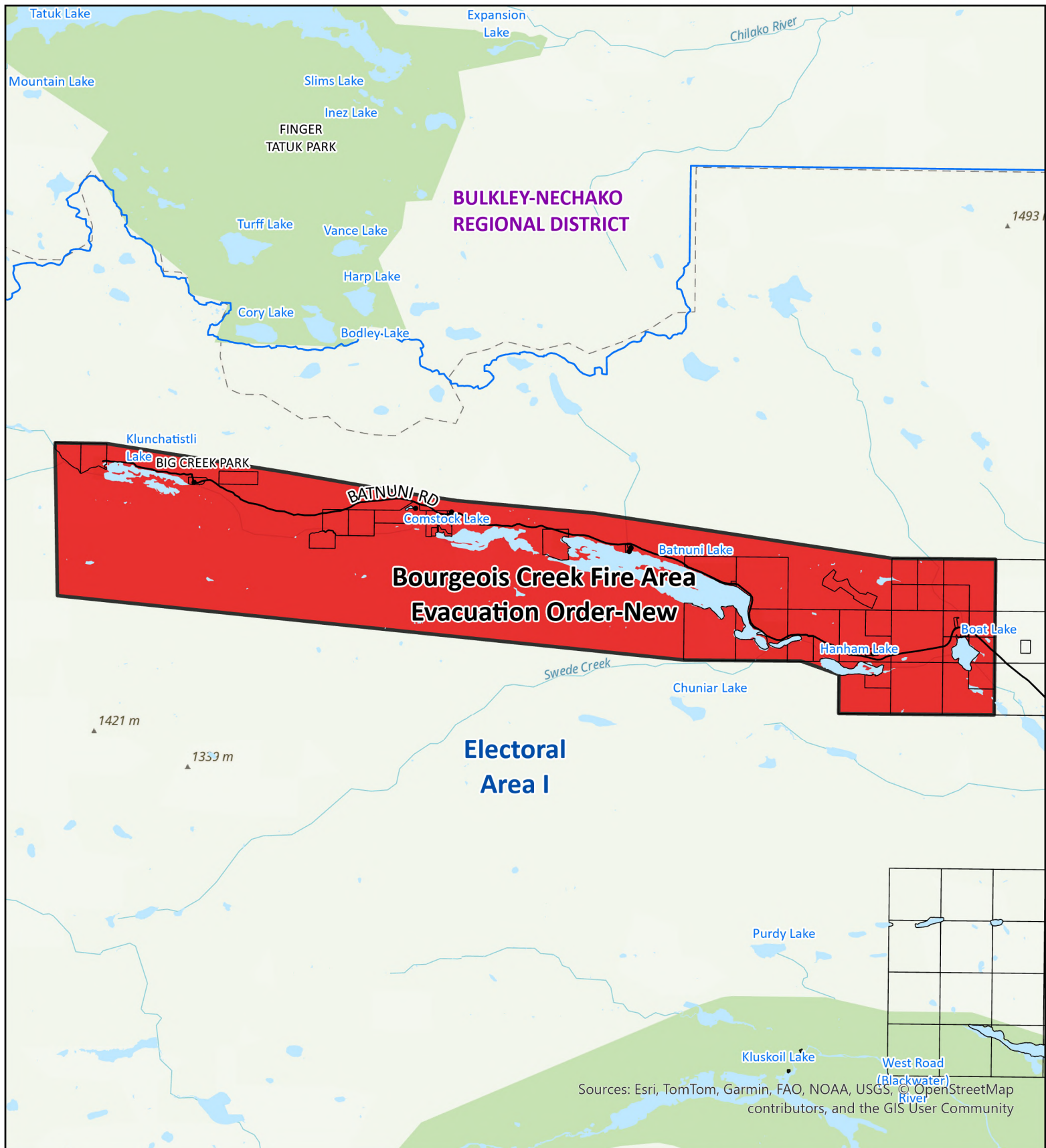
- Do not shut off your natural gas. FortisBC will turn off natural gas service as needed.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
- Do not use more vehicles than you must.
- To receive Emergency Support Services, please self-register using the Evacuee Registration & Assistance (ERA) tool at <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/>, (if not already done) and call 250-983-3638 to receive assistance.
- If you have homeowners' or tenants' insurance, contact your insurance provider to arrange for living expenses such as accommodation and food.
- Residents who choose not to evacuate should understand they stay at their own risk. Responders may not be able to come to your rescue if it is unsafe to do so.

BOURGEOIS CREEK FIRE AREA EVACUATION ORDER, JULY 22, 2026 08:45 PM



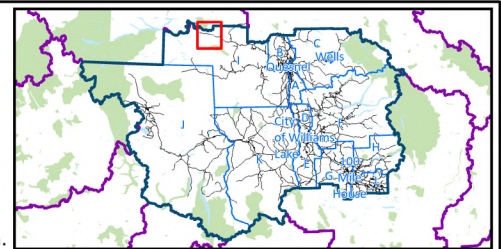
