Kluskus, Blackwater, Clisbako, Nazko Area #2

EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED

Sunday, August 27, 2017 at 11:00 am

Pursuant to the BC Emergency Program Act, an updated Evacuation Order has been issued by the Cariboo Regional District. This order is reflecting the downgrade of an area Northeast of the Nazko area to alert and is replacing the Kluskus, Blackwater, Clisbako & Nazko Area Expansion #1 order issued on August 17, 2017 at 9:00 pm.

Due to immediate danger to **life safety** due to fire, members of the RCMP or other groups will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following area:

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area **immediately**
- Close all windows and doors
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock
- Gather your family: take a neighbour or someone who needs help
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and Keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
