
# **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Board of Directors of the Cariboo Regional District gives notice that it will hold a Public Hearing to consider proposed Bylaw 5510.

North Cariboo Area Rural Land Use Amendment Bylaw No. 5510, 2025 amends Bylaw No. 3505, 1999 by rezoning part of the property from Resource/Agricultural (R/A) zone to Rural 1 (RR1) zone.

If passed, it will allow for a two-lot subdivision.

All persons who believe that their interest in property may be affected by the proposed Bylaw(s) shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard at the public hearing. Written submissions (via the options below) must be submitted at our Williams Lake Office forty-eight hours prior to the hearing. All verbal and written submissions will become part of the public record.
