EVACUATION ORDER

Sunday, September 7, 2025 at 1:00 PM

Whereas a declaration of a state of local emergency was declared on 2025-09-07 by the Cariboo Regional District pursuant to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to wildfire within the jurisdiction of the Cariboo Regional District;

And whereas Section 107 (1)(c) and (d) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* authorizes requiring evacuations in relation to a declared state of local emergency, making arrangements for the adequate care and protection of evacuated persons and animals, and controlling travel to or from an area;

And whereas the *Smokey Lake Wildfire* is a significant threat to the health, safety, and welfare of persons, such that an evacuation and controlling travel is necessary to minimize threats;

This **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Cariboo Regional District and is effective as of September 7, 2025 at 1:00 PM and is in effect for the following areas:

Proceed to Highway 20 then head east to Williams Lake. For those who need additional resources, report to the ESS Centre at Cariboo Memorial Recreation Complex, 525 Proctor Street, Williams Lake to register, receive assistance, and for refreshments.

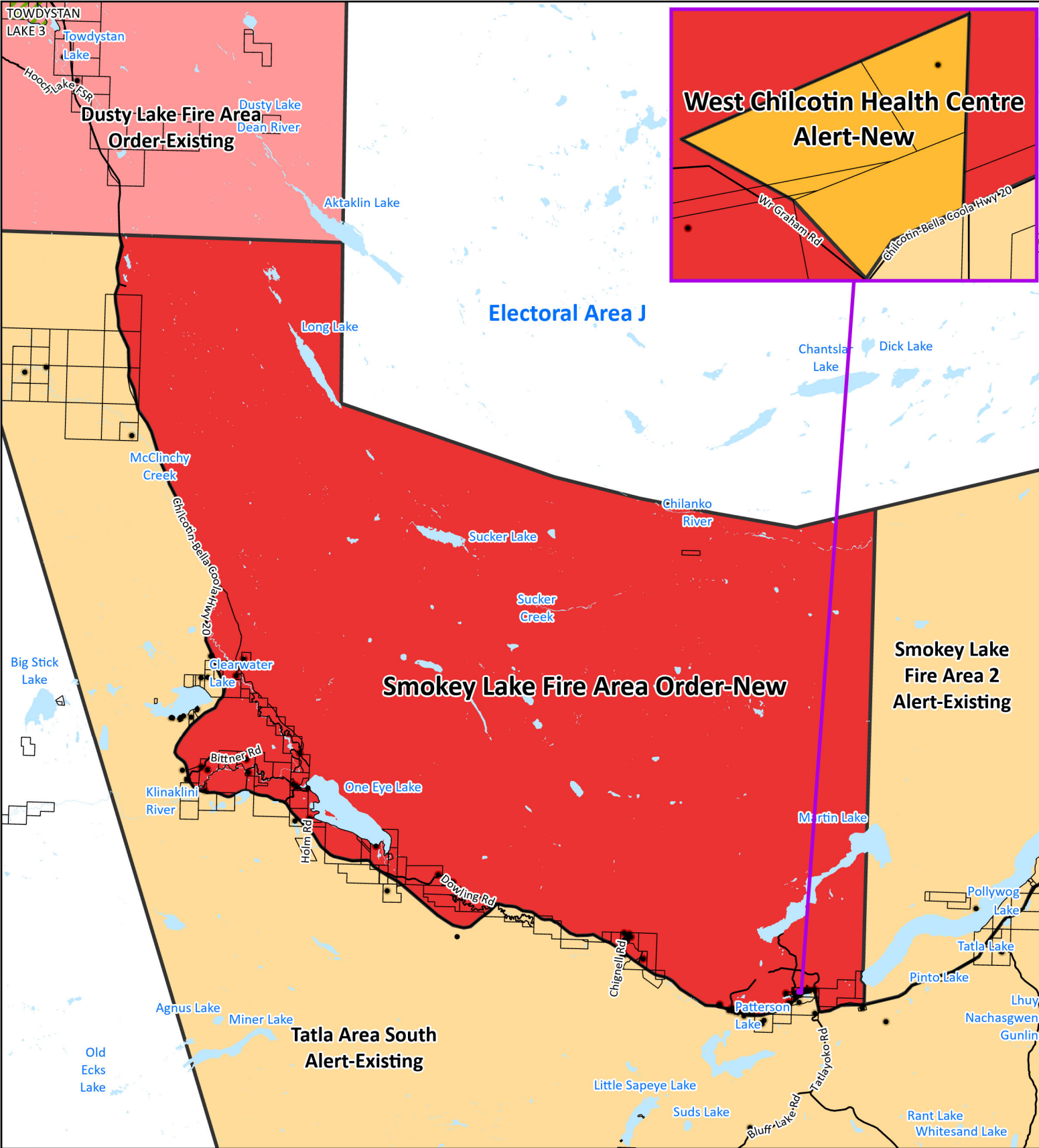
YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

SMOKEY LAKE FIRE AREA ORDER, SEPTEMBER 7, 2025 01:00 PM

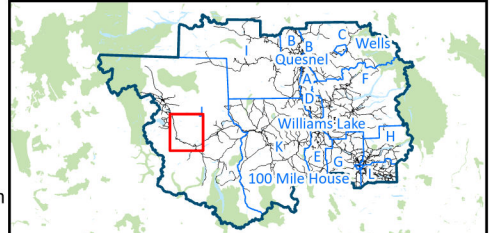


Legend
