Material	Description	Do not include
Flyers & newspapers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Daily and community newspapers and advertising flyers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plastic bags used to cover newspapers/flyers</li> <li>Rubber bands</li> </ul>
Magazines & catalogues 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All types</li> </ul>	
Telephone books 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Phone books and directories</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hardcover or paperback books (donate or sell)</li> </ul>
Paper gift wrap & greeting cards 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Non-paper gift wrap</li> <li>Ribbons or bows</li> <li>Musical greeting cards with batteries</li> </ul>
Writing/home office paper & correspondence 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Note pads</li> <li>Loose leaf paper</li> <li>White or coloured computer, copier and printer paper</li> <li>Printed paper</li> <li>Plain and window envelopes</li> <li>Shredded paper</li> </ul> <p>Place shredded paper securely inside a paper bag or box (to prevent litter) during collection.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Padded envelopes</li> </ul>

## Paper Packaging for Dry Goods

Material	Description	Do not include
<b>Corrugated cardboard boxes</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shipping boxes</li> <li>Grocery and liquor store boxes</li> <li>Pizza boxes</li> </ul> <p>Staples and tape are OK, make sure boxes are empty.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cardboard boxes with wax coating, e.g., empty shipping boxes made available for residents to transport their groceries home</li> </ul>
<b>Cardboard &amp; boxboard</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Boxes for cereal, shoes, tissues, pizza, frozen entrees, desserts, detergent, etc.</li> <li>Carrier trays for bulk bottled water, soft drinks, cans, food, etc.</li> <li>Cores for paper towel and toilet tissue</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Paper towels or napkins</li> <li>Tissues</li> <li>Food waste</li> <li>Liner bags</li> </ul> <p>Do not stack boxes inside each other.</p>
<b>Moulded boxboard packaging</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Egg cartons</li> <li>Take-out beverage trays</li> <li>Empty paper-based garden pots, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dirt in garden pots</li> </ul>
<b>Paper bags (kraft paper)</b> 	<p>Any colour, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Brown grocery sacks</li> <li>White prescription bags</li> <li>Brown envelopes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Padded envelopes</li> <li>Foil-lined bags, e.g., packaged cookies</li> </ul>
<b>Multi-layer paper bags</b> 	<p>Multi-layered bags for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pet food</li> <li>Flour</li> <li>Sugar, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Bags can include a plastic film layer.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bags with a foil layer</li> </ul>






## Cartons and Paper Cups

Material	Description	Do not include
Paper cups 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hot and cold beverage cups</li> </ul> Remove lids and paper sleeves, recycle these items separately.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Straws</li> <li>Liquid beverage (empty first)</li> <li>Dirty cups (rinse first)</li> </ul>
Gable-top cartons 	Cartons for Milk and: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Milk-type beverages</li> <li>Cream</li> <li>Egg substitute</li> <li>Sugar</li> <li>Molasses, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Juice cartons (return for deposit refund)</li> <li>Attached plastic screw lids – remove first and recycle separately</li> <li>Dirty cartons (rinse first)</li> </ul>
Aseptic boxes or cartons 	Cartons for Milk and: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Milk-type beverages</li> <li>Cream</li> <li>Soup</li> <li>Broth</li> <li>Sauces, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Juice/drink boxes (return for deposit refund)</li> <li>Straws</li> <li>Stand up pouches</li> <li>Attached plastic screw lids – remove first and recycle separately</li> <li>Dirty cartons (rinse first)</li> </ul>
Frozen dessert boxes 	Containers for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ice cream</li> <li>Frozen yogurt, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dirty containers (rinse first)</li> </ul>





## Containers

Material	Description	Do not include
Empty aerosol cans 	Cans for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Food</li> <li>Air fresheners</li> <li>Shaving cream</li> <li>Deodorant</li> <li>Hairspray, etc.</li> </ul> Remove caps and place loose in recycling container.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Spray paint cans</li> <li>Aerosol cans with any contents remaining</li> <li>Propane cylinders</li> <li>Attached caps, (remove caps and place separately in recycling)</li> </ul> Ensure cans are empty.






Material	Description	Do not include
<p>Spiral wound cans &amp; metal lids</p> 	<p>Cans for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Frozen juice concentrate</li> <li>Potato chips, nuts</li> <li>Cookie dough</li> <li>Coffee</li> <li>Baby formula, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Attached lids (remove lids and recycle separately)</li> </ul>
<p>Aluminum cans &amp; lids</p> 	<p>Cans for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Food, e.g., seafood</li> <li>Pet food, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Put metal lid inside can and squeeze slightly.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Propane tanks or 1 lb. propane bottles</li> <li>Deposit cans (return for deposit refund)</li> <li>Dirty cans (rinse first)</li> </ul>
<p>Steel cans &amp; lids</p> 	<p>Cans and lids for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Food, including pet food</li> <li>Tins for cookies, tea, chocolates, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Labels are OK.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dirty cans (rinse first)</li> <li>Steel beverage cans (return for deposit refund)</li> <li>Steel paint cans</li> <li>Pots, pans and baking trays</li> <li>Propane cylinders</li> <li>Metal toys</li> <li>Appliances</li> <li>Coat hangers, metal hardware or other scrap metal</li> <li>Wiring or metal cords, extension cords</li> </ul>
<p>Aluminum foil &amp; foil take-out containers</p> 	<p>Foil packaging including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wrap (aluminum foil)</li> <li>Take-out, pie and food tray containers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Chip or foil bags</li> <li>Foil wrap with paper backing for butter, cigarettes, etc.</li> <li>Foil-lined cardboard take-out containers or lids</li> <li>Dirty items (rinse first)</li> </ul>
<p>Plastic garden pots &amp; trays</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bedding plants</li> <li>Seedlings</li> <li>Vegetable plants, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Remove soil.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ceramic plant pots</li> <li>Lawn edging</li> <li>Tarps</li> <li>plastic furniture or toys</li> <li>Garden hoses</li> <li>Plastic string or rope</li> </ul>

## Containers (*cont.*)

Material	Description	Do not include
<p>Plastic bottles &amp; caps</p> 	<p>Bottles and caps for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Mouthwash, shampoos, conditioners etc.</li> <li>Food</li> <li>Pills and vitamins</li> <li>Dish soap, laundry products, household cleaners, auto cleaners, e.g., glass cleaner, windshield washer fluid, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Beverage bottles (return for deposit refund)</li> <li>Stand up pouches</li> <li>Containers for motor oil, vehicle lubricant, or antifreeze products (recycle at BUCOMA depot)</li> <li>Container contents (rinse first)</li> <li>Caps or spray pumps attached to containers (remove first then add to recycling)</li> </ul>
<p>Plastic jars &amp; lids</p> 	<p>Jars and lids for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Peanut butter, jam, nuts, condiments</li> <li>Vitamins and supplements</li> <li>Personal care products and cosmetics</li> <li>Pharmaceuticals, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dirty jars (rinse first)</li> <li>Attached lids (remove first then add to recycling)</li> </ul>
<p>Plastic jugs with screw tops</p> 	<p>Jugs and lids for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Milk, cooking oil</li> <li>Laundry detergent, fabric softener, cleaning solutions, and cleaning products</li> <li>Body care products</li> <li>Windshield washer fluid, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Jugs for flavoured tea, juice, other beverages (return for deposit refund)</li> <li>Dirty jugs (rinse first)</li> </ul>
<p>Plastic clamshells</p>  <p><i>Containers are clear with hinged or click-closed tops.</i></p>	<p>Clamshells for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Baked goods</li> <li>Fruit and produce</li> <li>Eggs, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Labels are OK.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Packaging labelled biodegradable or compostable</li> <li>Liquid-absorbing pads</li> <li>Dirty clamshells (rinse first)</li> </ul>



## Containers (*cont.*)

Material	Description	Do not include
<b>Plastic trays &amp; tops</b>  <i>Containers are clear or have black bottom trays with clear domes.</i>	Trays and tops for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deli chicken, single serve meals, prepared foods, and baked goods</li> <li>• Housewares and hardware, e.g. screws, picture hangers, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• White, black or colour foam trays (take to recycling depot)</li> <li>• Soft plastic packaging for perishable foods, e.g. meat, poultry, fish or cheese, etc.</li> <li>• Plastic/foil packaging for items like chewing gum and pills</li> <li>• Dirty items (rinse first)</li> </ul>
<b>Plastic tubs &amp; lids</b> 	Tubs for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Margarine and spreads</li> <li>• Yogurt, cottage cheese, sour cream, ice cream, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Packaging labelled biodegradable or compostable</li> <li>• Plastic or foil lids from coffee and tea pods</li> <li>• Coffee grounds (compost)</li> <li>• Dirty items (rinse first)</li> </ul>
<b>Plastic cold drink cups with lids</b> 	Take out cups for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All types of beverages</li> </ul> Remove lids and place loose in recycling container.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Foam cups</li> <li>• Plastic packaging labelled biodegradable or compostable</li> <li>• Napkins</li> <li>• Straws</li> <li>• Dirty items (rinse first)</li> </ul>
<b>Plastic pails</b> 	Pails smaller than 25L for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Laundry detergent</li> <li>• Ice cream</li> <li>• Pet food, etc.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plastic paint cans</li> <li>• Plastic pails larger than 25L</li> <li>• Pails for lubricants and oils</li> </ul>
<b>Microwavable bowls &amp; cups</b> 	For soups and entrees Remove lids and place loose in recycling container.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bowls with metal rims</li> <li>• Napkins</li> <li>• Cutlery</li> </ul>



## Glass

Material	Description	Do not include
<p>Non-deposit glass bottles &amp; Jars</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clear or coloured</li> <li>• Remove lids and recycle separately</li> <li>• Empty and rinse bottles and jars</li> </ul> <p>Labels OK.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Drinking glasses, dishes, cookware, whole or broken window glass or mirrors</li> <li>• Ceramic mugs or other ceramic products</li> </ul>

## Plastic Bags and Overwrap

Material	Description	Do not include
<p>Plastic bags &amp; overwrap</p> 	<p>Plastic bags for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• groceries, dry cleaning, bread, produce, dry bulk foods, and most frozen vegetables</li> </ul> <p>Outer bags and wrap for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• diapers, feminine hygiene products, paper towels, tissues, soft drink can flats; bags for water softener salt, wood pellets and garden products</li> </ul> <p>Overwrap on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• mattresses, furniture and electronic equipment</li> </ul> <p>All bags should be free of food residue and products.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Crinkly cellophane wrap, for tea, floral arrangements, etc.</li> <li>• Stand up pouches</li> <li>• Bags for pre-washed salad</li> <li>• Kitchen stretch wrap or plastic wrap for meat, poultry, fish or cheese</li> <li>• Chip or snack bags</li> <li>• Zipper-lock sandwich and freezer bags</li> <li>• Plastic shipping envelopes</li> <li>• Packaging labelled biodegradable or compostable</li> <li>• Soft packaging for perishable foods, e.g. bacon, deli meats, cheese slices, fish, etc.</li> <li>• Lumber or construction wrap</li> <li>• Garbage bags or recycling – e.g. “blue bags” or any bag sold as a product (all colours)</li> </ul>

## Foam Packaging (Styrofoam)

Material	Description	Do not include
<p>Foam food trays &amp; containers</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Meat trays</li> <li>Foam egg cartons</li> <li>Foam clamshells</li> <li>Foam cups and bowls for take-out food, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Sort white and coloured foam into appropriate collection container at depot.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Liquid-absorbing pads</li> <li>Shrink wrap for meat, poultry, fish, cheese, etc.</li> <li>Napkins</li> <li>Food residue</li> </ul>
<p>Foam cushion packaging</p> 	<p>Foam cushion packaging used to protect:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Electronics</li> <li>Small appliances, etc.</li> </ul> <p>Sort white and coloured foam into appropriate collection container at depot</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Labels, tape</li> <li>Paper and cardboard (recycle separately)</li> <li>Foam peanuts, packing chips or noodles</li> <li>Blue/pink foam board insulation</li> <li>Squishy or flexible foam</li> <li>Foam furniture (e.g. sofa cushions)</li> </ul>

## Deposit Beverage Containers:

Please do not include deposit beverage containers (alcoholic or non-alcoholic) in the glass or container bin. Return for refund at a bottle depot or donate them to cause of your choice. The deposit is lost if they are included with CRD depot materials.
