Report regarding 2010 Grant for Assistance

Dear Mr. Richmond:

We would like to express our sincere thanks for the 2010 Grant for Assistance (\$800) to the South Cariboo Sustainability Society. This letter will also serve as a report and update about how the funds were utilised.

When we applied for the grant, the SCSS was a relatively new organisation, and there was a need to raise the profile of the Sustainability Society within the community. We knew we needed to build awareness about our society, its goals, and how its activities might be of service to the community. To this end, we sought funding assistance in two main areas. First, we requested support for expenses for maintaining booths at 3 major community events. Second, we sought funding to print more of our brochures which provide information about the society. I am pleased to say that we have successfully completed the activities in both of these areas.

Here is how the funds were spent:

Seedy Saturday Event April 2, 2011	\$25.00
Home Show/ Mega Show April 29- May 1, 2011	\$147.00
Print more SCSS brochures	\$391.91
Total spent	\$733.31

The remaining funds (\$66.69) will be used towards developing a website for the Sustainability Society. This website should further assist us in developing and maintaining a high profile in the community and region. In addition, we hope that the website might serve as a tool for residents to communicate with each other about topics related to Sustainability.
