## Evacuation alert issued for Intersection of Upper Dog Creek Road and Gustafson Dog Creek FSR Area

*Williams Lake, B.C.* – Effective immediately, the Cariboo Regional District has issued an evacuation alert for 1 property at the Intersection of Upper Dog Creek Road and Gustafson Dog Creek FSR Area.

An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property should it be required. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Upon notification of an **ALERT**, you should be prepared for the evacuation order by:

- Having a plan to transport all family members or co-workers outside of the area, should the area be brought under evacuation order.
- Keeping essential items readily available for a quick departure; including medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), immediate care needs for dependents and, if you choose, keepsakes (photographs, etc).
- Ensuring that any dependents are prepared for departure.
- Moving pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Ensuring that you have accommodation options for your family, if possible. A Reception Centre will be made available if required.
- Monitoring reliable news sources for information on evacuation orders and locations of Reception Centers and the CRD's channels on Facebook and [cariboord.ca](http://cariboord.ca).
