Evacuation order issued for one property in the Borland Creek – 150 Mile House Area

Williams Lake, B.C. – Effective immediately, the Cariboo Regional District has issued an evacuation order for one property in the Borland Creek - 150 Mile House area due to flooding.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area immediately.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Do not shut off your natural gas.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather your family: take a neighbour or someone who needs help.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
- If you are on an **evacuation ALERT or ORDER**, or if you have been displaced from your home due to an emergency, Please self-register with Emergency Support Services (ESS) at <https://ess.gov.bc.ca/> . Self-Registration will reduce wait times for evacuees and assist in the referral process.

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY.
